Cheers to the end of the 109th year of the Junior League of Washington!

With the JLW's 109th year now closed, I'm reflecting on all we've accomplished this last year and how we are focusing on a bright future!



Thanks to our dedicated members, the 2021-2022 JLW year was a memorable one. Despite the uncertainty and changing conditions presented by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, our members once again showed their resiliency, rising to each challenge to support our members and the DC community in a meaningful way. I'm grateful for our members' efforts in ensuring the League's mission was fulfilled.

Our theme Centering Our Community was at the heart of everything we accomplished - and after more than a year of being remote, engaging members was a priority. Finding ways to bring everyone together was a big part of our mission for the year, especially once we were able to re-engage in person as the year progressed.

Together we've found new ways to support our long-standing community partners, which created more impact for them and JLW. We also engaged new community partners, and built bridges to other community organizations through our Community Roundtables. We built upon what we learned from our Community Assistance Fund last year, and these grants, in amounts up to \$5,000 each for urgent, basic needs, are now a part of our regular grants portfolio, allowing us to connect and support more members and organizations in our community.

Our in-League and fundraising placements have brought our members together in virtual, hybrid, and in-person formats to reach members where they are, and expand their programming to offer a robust selection of trainings, speakers, and fellowship activities to learn and grow. The Strategic Sustainability Council (SSC) focused on strategies to further our mission. The board tasked SSC with developing infrastructure and investing in the advancement of diversity, equity, inclusion, and belonging within our JLW community, which is one prong of the JLW Strategic Plan 2027. The new strategic plan begins with the 2022-2023 year, and sets forth goals for building belonging, building community capacity, building for change, and building our brand and relationships. This issue will highlight the new plan and how JLW will set it in motion. Lastly, our new focus area, in effect on June 1, will expand our work and community impact.

There's so much to come in the next few years, and I'm excited to see how JLW grows! Our members are the center of our JLW community, and I know that the sky's the limit of what JLW members can achieve when they come together.

It's been my honor to serve as JLW President. I'm so thankful I had the opportunity this spring to meet so many of our members at events and volunteer opportunities. I'll be forever grateful to all of you for your trust and support in granting me the opportunity. 

REFRESHED & REDONE: THE NEW LOOK OF KITCHEN TOURS

Embracing the need for change and innovation, the 2022 Kitchen Tours underwent some renovation this past year. To meet League members where they were, Committee Chairs, Annie Morgan and Sophie Barry, created an array of hybrid programming: a series of virtual pre-events and a virtual recipe collection, all culminating in an in-person garden party.



In years past, the event would include walking tours of homes in different neighborhoods throughout the DC-area in an effort to introduce members to beautiful design and decor in new parts of the city. But, with many homeowners still uneasy about having hundreds of people walk through their homes, the committee took a different approach to engage with members. Rather than focus on diversity of neighborhood, the committee looked to create events with cultural diversity and adopted an international theme.

"This year, no matter what the format, we knew that we wanted to center the Kitchen Tour around a theme of cultural sharing and diversity. After all, hosting is a way of bringing people together and exchanging ideas - something that eventually we'll all be able to do again," shared 2021-2022 Co-Chair Sophie Barry.

With around 60 members attending in February and April, respectively, the "Around the World Craft Cocktail Class" and "Taste of Italy" virtual events were a rousing way to kick off Kitchen Tour 2022.

To put together the second edition of the Kitchen Tour virtual recipe collection, over 100 recipes were collected from JLW members. Used as a fundraiser, those who donated received a copy of the digital booklet including dishes spanning from classic Southern comfort food to flavorful Caribbean entrees.

To conclude the series, the Kitchen Tour Committee hosted an event evoking springtime around the world at JLW Headquarters, the Loughborough House in Georgetown, on April 30, 2022. Approximately 200 people attended the Kitchen Tour Garden Party, which took place in both the indoor and outdoor spaces of the historic house. Cuisine, musical selections, and decor were all carefully curated to embrace the theme and highlight local and international cultures.

LIBRARY OF CONGRESS' ANNUAL NATIONAL BOOK FESTIVAL


For nearly two decades, the Junior League of Washington (JLW) has provided volunteer support to the Library of Congress' annual National Book Festival. Since its inception, the event has become one of the most prominent literary events in the country and with more than 43,000 hours pledged over the years, this partnership is among one of the League's most cherished.

"For 19 years, we have provided thousands of volunteers and hours of service to support the National Book Festival, which brings together the power of books, reading, and education to visitors from across the country," said Amanda Walke, 2021-2022 president of the Junior League of Washington.

The 2021 festival was held from September 17-26 and hosted by television personality reading advocate, LeVar Burton. The festival included a wide array of events, Q&As, interviews across live and virtual platforms showcasing nearly 100 authors, poets, and illustrators.

Themed "Open a Book, Open the World," the festival highlighted the impact that reading can have on an individual and their world view. This theme was especially impactful as JLW moved towards its new focus area of supporting pathways to opportunity through improved access to education, professional and financial development, and capacity building resources in our community.

"Since 2003, the Junior League of Washington has been honored to partner and support this event, and we look forward to continuing our relationship for years to come," said Walke.





THE LASTING IMPACT OF HORTON'S KIDS

An interview with Miranda Summers Lowe, a longtime volunteer.

As part of its focus area creating pathways to opportunity, the Junior League of Washington (JLW) through its continued partnership with Horton's Kids, understands the positive impact that tutoring and mentorship can have in shaping the younger generation.

What made you choose to volunteer on the Horton's Kids Committee and what has kept you coming back?

I was interested in Horton's Kids because of the youth engagement and because they work so much close to the Capitol Hill area. I found that I was much more engaged as a volunteer when I could easily show up to an event or volunteer shift without a lot of commuting fuss. I come back because the kids are wonderful, I learn a lot about what's happening in my local community, the new education methods, and the flexibility in earning committee points.

What do you believe is the importance or lasting legacy of our partnership with Horton's Kids

Horton's Kids has evolved a lot as an organization in my five years on the committee. I believe that because there have always been Junior League volunteers available, the staff feel that they can try new things, take risks, and expand their programming.

What has been the most rewarding aspect of the committee?

I tutored the same young lady through elementary and middle school. When she graduated from high school, I cried. In an area with such low high school graduation rates, I truly felt like the work that the Junior League and Horton's Kids did set her up with a huge advantage in life.

What has been something you have learned while volunteering for Horton's Kids?

I don't usually work with kids, and so some of the training that Hortons Kids offers volunteers on education, talking to children, building mentorship relationships, or tutoring methods has been really helpful. Now that I've met the people who live [in Anacostia] and spent time there, I understand that East of the River is a warm, vibrant community, home for a lot of DC residents.

What is a piece of advice you'd give someone wanting to get involved with Horton's Kids

My best advice is that it gets better if you stay on the committee for a while. It can be hard to build relationships with the kids if you only see them a few times a year at events. But once you get to know them, it's amazing to watch them learn and grow. I think you also get more skilled as a volunteer.


LITTLE BLACK DRESS INITIATIVE ARRIVES IN WASHINGTON, DC

In early October of 2021, the Junior League of Washington (JLW) held its second annual Little Black Dress Initiative (LBDI). LBDI volunteers, called "advocates," participate by wearing the same black outfit for five consecutive days to illustrate the limitations that poverty placeson women's access to resources, their confidence, and advancement opportunities. Each advocate is able to internalize the experience to gain a deeper understanding of these aspects of poverty and share her realizations, along with information about poverty in the region, to raise awareness on social media of unmet needs in our community. In addition to pre-approved facts and imagery, advocates posted a selfie of themselves in their outfit or mask on their social media under the hashtag #LDBI.

Advocates are also expected to leverage their networks to raise funds for a designated cause. For JLW's October 2021 LBDI event, that cause was the Community Assistance Fund (CAF), which was formed in May 2020 as part of JLW's response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

LBDI was held between Monday, October 18 and Friday, October 22.

In LBDI's second league year in Washington, 55 participating advocates raised 615 donations from 495 unique donors, which amounted to \$29,251.19 in total to invest back in our community!




